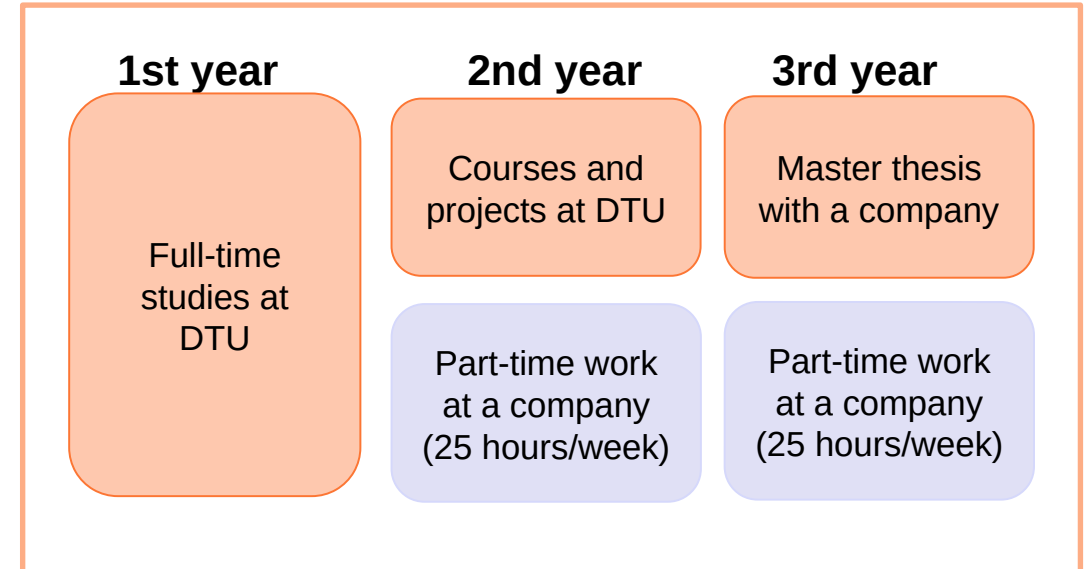

What is an Industry Master of Science in Engineering?

- An Industry Master is an alternative way to obtain a master's degree where students combine their studies with part-time employment at a company
- The programme spans three years:
 - The first year is full-time at DTU, while the second year is part-time at DTU and part-time in a company (an average of 25 hours per week over a year). In the third year, the student writes their master's thesis in collaboration with the company while also working part-time.
- It is natural for the company and the student to jointly plan a relevant study programme and thesis topic.



Example on a weekly schedule for the 2nd year
